2025 Annual Report

Dear Friends and Supporters of Home Care Partners,

We are pleased to share this Report for 2025. As we reflect on the year, we remember how Home Care Partners continued its mission without wavering, despite major changes and uncertainty related to policies and funding that could impact long-term care.

In 2025, we filled a major gap in the home care landscape in our region, providing services for seniors and adults with disabilities in DC, Arlington, Montgomery, and Prince George's Counties. We serve a population that is often caught in the middle — unable to pay for private services, but ineligible for Medicaid or other traditional assistance. Rather than being left behind, our caring and compassionate home care aides assisted them with activities of daily living, promoting independence and helping to prevent crises. Our home care aides also received highly competitive wages and expanded benefits, including retirement matches and support for license renewal fees.

Our Safe at Home program continued to lead the nation in combating fall risk among seniors. Our team worked tirelessly to complete critical home modifications, stretching our budget as far as possible despite rising costs in materials and labor related to global events. This work has tangibly made seniors' living environments safer, reducing falls and other safety hazards. Additionally, we greatly expanded the fall prevention education we provide to the DC community, including exercise classes and innovative fall prevention workshops held at senior community sites and virtually, so seniors can access the information from home.

In addition, our DC Caregivers' Institute continues to serve a critical population. National reports found that last year 59 million caregivers of adults provided 49.5 billion hours of care. Our program addresses the unique stresses of caregiving by providing respite care, financial reimbursements, support groups, and other services tailored to family caregivers. We also relaunched an extensive online learning portal, allowing caregivers to access support and resources 24/7 whenever it is most convenient for them.

Finally, Home Care Partners continues to advance local advocacy efforts for seniors and caregivers. We remain active participants in the DC Coalition on Long Term Care, and our staff serve on various advisory groups for government agencies.

In this report, you'll read more about our work and the dedicated staff who keep our high-quality programs running smoothly. We are deeply grateful to our donors, supporters, and friends who stand with us each and every day.

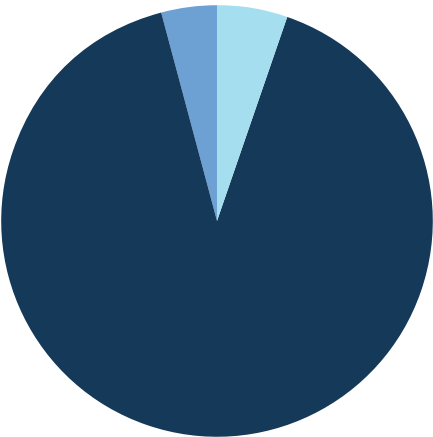

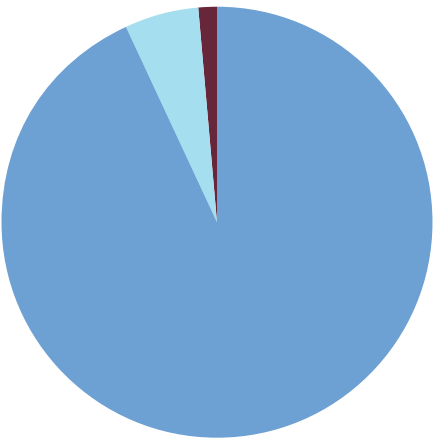

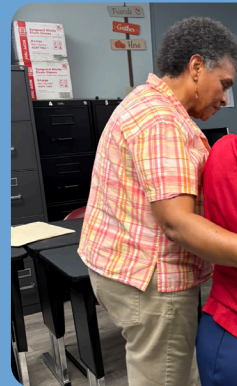
